# CYIA Summer Missionary Internship Program

## TERMS, CONDITIONS & FINANCIAL ACKNOWLEDGMENT AGREEMENT

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Applicants and/or their parents/guardians acknowledge and agree (check as appropriate):

- This is a 2-phase selection process: Application Phase and the Internship Program Phase (employment or volunteer). An applicant must complete all necessary requirements to become a CYIA Summer Missionary Intern.
- Applicants and/or parents/guardians acknowledge reading and agreeing to the full-length CYIA Summer Missionary Internship Terms and Conditions which includes applicant requirements, dress code, statement of faith, ministry compliance agreement, financial policy, child protection policy, and other items of importance. Likewise, attest to having watched the Child Protection Policy video provided online as required and so indicated on the online application.
- Interns and/or parents/guardians authorize CEF office to contact listed references for acceptance into the CYIA Summer Missionary Internship Program.
- Approved applicants may be asked to participate in solicitation support to their own network of family, friends and acquaintances or to participate in fund raising events in support of the Internship Program
- Interns must show competence in the methods and techniques of child evangelism by accurately demonstrating use of the materials as taught at CYIA Everest Training School.
- Interns may serve as either a volunteer or an employee. If Intern will be hired as an employee, applicant must complete the ADP onboarding process and, as necessary, sign all paperwork including but not limited to: Compensation Statement; I-9 Citizenship Verification; IRS W-4 Withholding; and weekly timecards.
- Interns and/or parents/guardians acknowledge that Interns may be dropped from the program for failure to abide by the Terms and Conditions; misrepresentation of Christian character or the reputation of CEF; disregard for authority; or disregard for the safety and respect of others. Additionally, paid Interns are required to abide by the policies of the Employee Handbook and USA Operations & Policy Manual
- Interns who may choose to serve by driving their own vehicles or parents/guardians who permit the use of their vehicle by the Intern to transport CYIA Summer Missionary Intern teams to ministry locations acknowledge their own automobile insurance policy is responsible for any potential liabilities before the liability insurance of Child Evangelism Fellowship of South Carolina, Inc. shall be provided.
- Interns may be requested to ride at their own discretion to ministry locations with approved screened drivers. Should the Intern suspect possible endangerment, they must report any cause for concern to the local director immediately. Passengers are expected to follow all state vehicular laws as well as fully respect the driver's instructions for safety and vehicle maintenance.
